

Route Plans to (1) Wolfeton House and (2) Nether Adber

(1) Wolfeton House: (Friday 12th June at 2.00pm)

Grid reference: SY 678 922

The house is situated 1½ miles from Dorchester off the B3147, close to its junction with the A37, and is indicated by Historic House signs. Travelling down the A37 from Yeovil, go through Grimstone and passed Stratton, then, just before reaching Dorchester, there is a roundabout. To the right, the A37 becomes the Dorchester bypass and to the left, the B3147 goes straight into Dorchester town centre. Take the B3147 (first exit off the roundabout) and in a little over 100 yards there is a turning on the left (immediately at the end of the tall hedge) into a narrow track which leads directly to Wolfeton House. Take this left turn which crosses a cattle grid and runs straight across a meadow and over the River Frome to Wolfeton House. There are two blue and white 'Wolfeton House' signs on the B3147 and a black and white notice at the cattle grid.

Please note that visitors are advised not to use the House's post code and their Sat Navs because this usually takes you on a more difficult route through Charminster village. It effectively leads to the back door of the House which is not the right entrance

(2) Nether Adber: (Saturday 8th August at 2.00pm)

Grid reference: ST 588 212 or 358839, 121263

Nether Adber is on a lane off the A359, between Mudford and Marston Magna. Travelling north from Yeovil, go through Mudford and over the River Yeo, through the cross roads with Hinton (to the left) and Sandford Orcas (to the right). Go past the left turning to Chilton Cantello and then take the next turning (unsign-posted) on the right. If you reach the Marston Inn, you have gone too far. Go down this lane less than half a mile and the lane will bend sharply to the right with a notice on the left which says 'Unsuitable for Motor vehicles'. On the bend there is a field gate (also on the left) which gives access to the site.
